NOTICE IS GIVEN that we are applying to the Consistory Court of the diocese for permission to carry out the following:

Installation of a Wi-Fi antenna on the Church Tower, to enable a link to pickup the Broadband connection from the Church Room. The antenna is relatively small, being abut 150mm x 75mm. It is white plastic, but will be at such a height as to be relatively inconspicuous. The intention is to mount it near the existing timber Bell Tower louvres, thus enabling the cable to enter the Bell Tower without the need for drilling through the stone walls. Cabling will then be taken down the internal Bell Tower to an Access Point lower down in the Church or Ringing Chamber. Exact positioning will have to be by trial and error, due to the thick stone walls. Further electronic components will be hidden in the Bell Tower, as will all the cabling.
